

Jan Doležel - CV - 900 characters

Jan Doležel (*1984 in Pilsen, Czech Republic) is appreciated by public and critics for his supreme mastery of the instrument, his art of registration and his distinctive playing.

With his ability to create musical tension and his sense of drama, he has repeatedly excited audiences in several European countries.

He studied music in Pilsen (Adam Viktora), Prague (Jaroslav Tůma), Lübeck (Franz Danksagmüller, Hans-Jürgen Schnoor) and Würzburg (Christoph Bossert). He has won prizes in several competitions (including ION 2013) and was a scholarship holder from the Evangelisches Studienwerk.

In his intense concert activity, Jan Doležel attaches great importance to the performance of significant and rarely played compositions.

Since 2012 Doležel teaches organ at the University of Music in Würzburg. Since 2018 he teaches music at the Friedrich-Alexander-University Erlangen.
